How to Receive and Submit Your Application

In keeping with the tradition of our national organization, Sigma Omicron Zeta encourages academic and community service excellence in the Gwinnett County area. The chapter awards well-deserving high school females with scholarships for academic and community service excellence.

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- Must be a young lady in her senior year, attending a Gwinnett County HS
- Must have a 2.5 or higher GPA
- Must be in good standing at school and in the community
- Must submit a completed scholarship application with:
 - List of community service, clubs/organizations, awards/honors, talents
 - Completed essay question
 - Official high school transcript or GED certificate
- Must be accepted to and enroll in an accredited two-year community or technical college, or four-year public or private university
- Must provide proof of acceptance at a post-secondary institution
- Must meet application submission deadline
- Must provide proof of college enrollment in term immediately following high school graduation for funds disbursement
